#### A Word About Safety Visors

APG safety visors and inner blast helmet lenses meet OSHA standards. It is the responsibility of the end user to ensure that the proper safety equipment is used for a specific hazard. APG visors and lenses are tested in accordance with ANSI and are capable of withstanding specific impact resistance tests without breaking. They will, however, break or shatter if struck by a heavy enough object or even lighter object traveling at sufficient speed. Manufacturers of safety visors and lenses cannot provide eye protection devices that completely eliminate the possibility of eye damage under all circumstances.

**Approval:** APG safety visors, headgear, Hard Hat Adapter, and Inner Blast Helmet Lenses meet or exceed the requirements of ANSI Z87.1 and CSA Z94.3-02

**Warning:** Medium green and dark green tint visors and lenses do not provide protection against harmful infrared and ultraviolet radiation.

**Caution:** Headgear with visors and blast helmets alone do not provide adequate eye protection. Such devices must be worn over primary safety glasses or goggles. Headgear with visors must be in "down" position and used with safety glasses or goggles to provide protection. Blast helmets must have inner lenses secured in gasket or housing to prevent leakage of silica. It is the responsibility of the end user to ensure that all blast helmet components are functioning properly. This includes but is not limited to the inner lens, air feed system and cape.
